Exploring the Explicit Knowledge of the Duchenne Marker and Asymmetry in Smile Judgment Siu Yun Kua, 2015 Research has shown that individuals are sensitive to the activation of the orbicularis oculi muscle Duchenne marker and are able to detect asymmetry It has been proposed that the differences in smile judgment performance might be explained by one s explicit knowledge regarding the morphological cues The goal of the study was to explore individuals explicit knowledge of the Duchenne marker and asymmetry in smile judgment tasks The present study also employed the Likert scale to examine the possible effect of response options on smile judgment tasks Participants also were asked to judge both the happiness and authenticity of smiles Three types of smiles symmetrical Duchenne non Duchenne and asymmetrical were presented for the smile judgment task Participants were also asked to indicate if they noticed symmetrical differences and cues in certain facial regions Results showed that the symmetrical Duchenne smiles were judged as being the most happy and authentic This was followed by the non Duchenne smiles while the asymmetrical smiles were judged as being the least happy and authentic This finding was similar to that found in a previous study that employed the Likert scale suggesting the possible influence of response options on smile judgment Similar results were obtained for both the happiness and authenticity judgment conditions implying that wording only had a minor influence on smile judgment Results also revealed that participants had good explicit knowledge about the morphological cues but it was not perfect Therefore the results suggested that explicit knowledge on its own is not sufficient to explain smile judgment performance

Does a Smile on Picture Day Keep the Doctor Away? The Connections Between Facial Expressions in Student Identification Photographs and Health Care Center Visitation Marie Patrice Cross,2016 Background These two studies examined whether facial expressions in student identification photographs were connected with health care center visitation Method In Study 1 participants N 267 completed a short online survey that detailed the number of times they had visited a health care center in the last year In Study 2 participants N 435 answered this same question but health care center visits were divided into four categories illness injury mood related and preventive In both studies the photographs on participants student identification cards were coded as no smile non Duchenne smile or Duchenne smile Results Logistic regressions revealed that in Study 1 participants with non Duchenne or Duchenne smiles were more likely to have visited a health care center in the past year than participants with no smile in their photograph However Study 2 revealed that this finding was driven by preventive health care center visits participants with non Duchenne or Duchenne smiles in their photographs were more likely to have visited a health care center visits participants with non Duchenne smiles in their photographs were more likely to have visited a health care center in the past year for preventive purposes than participants with no smile in their photograph No facial expression differences were found for health care center visits for illness injury or mood related concerns Conclusions Smiling in photographs is connected to preventive health care center visits a positive health behavior Future research should continue to investigate whether smiles in photographs are connected with other important health outcomes

The Mechanism of Human Facial Expression G. -B. The Effects of Social Exclusion on Facial Mimicry for the Five Types of Smiles Joseph C. Brandenberg,2019 Social exclusion influences our well being Baumeister DeWall Rychlowska et al 2017 utilizing the Cyberball task a ball tossing game commonly used to induce social exclusion or social inclusion People were outfitted with facial EMG sensors on their zygomaticus major and orbicularis oculi muscles Then they either were socially included or socially excluded and categorized four second video clips of the different smile types as either genuine or fake Next they were participated in the opposite condition of either socially excluded or socially included dependent on what they experienced first and then given the same categorization task I found people categorized dominance smiles faster and were more likely to categorize them as fake compared to the four other types of smiles Additionally in the within subjects design I found that people discriminated better between Duchenne smiles and non Duchenne in the second block of the experiment regardless of condition For facial mimicry I found a main effect of smile type for Duchenne smiles for zygomaticus major activity I also found exploratory mimicry data for differences in orbicularis oculi activity between the dominance and reward smiles Rychlowska et al 2017 These data conclude that participants were better at discriminating between Duchenne and non Duchenne in the second experiment block I also showed differences in facial mimicry for Duchenne non Duchenne reward affiliative and dominance smiles

Social Exclusion and Children's Detection of Duchenne Smiles, 2023 Social exclusion threatens a person s need to belong and prompts them to behave in ways that often facilitate reaffiliation For adults exclusion increases attention to social information and facial cues including an enhanced identification of Duchenne genuine and non Duchenne posed smiles There is some evidence that experiencing inclusion before or after exclusion can buffer or mitigate the experienced effects of exclusion respectively This study investigated whether 6 and 7 year old children N 24 are also sensitive to perceptual changes in smiles following witnessed inclusion and exclusion Contrary to our predictions children in our study did not demonstrate improved accuracy in smile identification after witnessing exclusion and instead demonstrated improved accuracy after witnessing inclusion Additionally we did not find support for any buffering or mitigating effects of witnessing inclusion These findings suggest that perhaps children are not yet as adept at making distinctions between Duchenne and non Duchenne smiles and or that witnessing inclusion and exclusion may not be equivalent to experiencing inclusion and exclusion
